**1. Membership rates 2019**

Membership year runs from the 1st October to 30th September each year.

Contact Membership Secretary for details of reduced rates for late joiners.

Membership includes a membership card, a welcome pack, liability insurance and BBKA Magazine from BBKA and BeeCraft Magazine. Please advise the membership secretary, if you do not receive any of the above.

Your membership also includes BDI Insurance, our monthly newsletter, seasonal meetings and lectures.

**2. Apiary**

If you are interested in a site for a hive at the Division Apiary please contact Apiary Manager.

Note that space is very limited and if available, will normally be a maximum of **two colonies**

**3. Gift aid**

Surrey Beekeepers' Association (Croydon is just one of eight Divisions) is a charity and able to reclaim tax you may have paid previously, proportional to the amount of your subscription – this is at no cost or detriment to you!

However you must be a tax payer: for instance have income from employment, a building society, bank, or pension and you pay tax on it. If in the last tax year you have paid more than £12.00p income tax or had that much deducted from a pension or withheld from a bank or building society account, you are eligible and Croydon Beekeepers will benefit directly.

If you do pay tax please sign the declaration on the first page (this is a standard format issued by the inland revenue) and we will be able to reclaim up to 25p for every pound you pay in subscription charges. **This is not a deed of covenant and you are not committed to any future payments.**

**4. Bee Disease Insurance**

If you have no bees at present, you are still required to have the minimum insurance i.e. £2.00.

If you are not familiar with this kind of insurance, ask the treasurer to send you details. The figures are for the total number of colonies and the rates are in addition to membership fees. Please note that nucleus hives and swarms are counted as colonies. If you have more than 20 colonies, please contact the Treasurer for the rates. Note that for legal reasons, junior members are not allowed to hold a Bee Disease insurance policy and a named adult must be nominated. Contact the treasurer if this applies to you.

**5. Privacy Statement**

We will store your details in our membership database. In order to receive your membership benefits, your details will be shared with Surrey Beekeepers Association, of whom we are a division, and also the British Beekeepers Association, Bee Disease Insurance [BDI], BeeCraft Magazine and the national Bee Unit, the government body responsible for honeybee legislation and health in the UK. These organizations will only use your details for their own purposes and will not release them to any other parties.
